Explanations for Zone 5 Clues BottleDrop®

CLUE 1

From nine counties you'll have to choose. Which of these gives you the blues?

SOLVE 1

There are nine counties in this zone. The Blue Mountains are in Union, Umatilla, Grant, Baker and Wallowa Counties eliminating 4 counties. The word "you" was a hint at Union if you caught it. This would give you Union and Umatilla Counties narrowing it further.

CLUE 2

Take the 2 from 64. Drop him and go explore.

SOLVE 2

Grant and Union Counties were formed in 1864. Grant County was named for Ulysses S. Grant. Eliminate him and you have Union.

CLUE 3

Don't go full Monty but you're getting near. Within 5 miles of this Mountaineer.

SOLVE 3

Eastern Oregon University's Mascot is Monty the Mountaineer. The Park is within 5 miles of here.

CLUE 4

If you went north you'd be happy as a lark. Across the river side you'll find a park.

SOLVE 4

Coming from the University, go north and cross the river to Riverside Park.

FOUND!



CLUE 5

There's no time to horseshoe around or put Spot in fences. Just take the path of the Hiroshima tree and pass the Lovely benches. Cross the bridge but don't go left to read a little story. Go straight instead, to the Mountain Pine, and there you'll find your glory.

SOLVE 5

Riverside Park has horseshoe pits close to the dog park area. Don't stay in that area, take the path towards the river. There are two benches on the path in memory of Walter & Peggy Lovely. There is also the Hiroshima Peace Tree just before you cross the bridge. Cook Memorial Library sponsors the Story Walk which is on the Riverside Greenway Trail, but instead of following the story walk, keep walking straight after you cross the bridge and you'll find the Mountain Pine (Mugo Pine) where the bottle is hidden!
